SFAfA Grant Examples

General Guidelines

(GIA and Tauber Funds are available for any case, please use all of your funds)

- 1 The pet must have an urgent need for medical care.
- The case has a good prognosis.
- If it's a long term problem, the clinic must be able to provide ongoing care.
- Your client must have exhausted all other financial options.
- Your hospital will provide a matching or greater discount/donation of in-kind services
- Your client must reside in, or have significant connection to, the San Francisco Bay Area.

Condition Examples

(List is not all inclusive. Please reach out to us with any questions!)

- Infectious diseases (Parvo virus, feline panleukopenia, influenza, anaplasmosis...
- Hepatitis / Liver Disease


